

Cape Media Junior Filmmakers Project

Course Description & Information

Hosted by the Cape Cod Community Media Center

August 3-14, 2009 from 10AM to 3PM

This two-week summer video course will teach students everything they need to know to produce a 5-10 minute television quality video - from storyboarding and scripting to acting, shooting and editing. This is a hands-on course that emphasizes teamwork and team building, as well as creativity and artistic composition. The workshop will have at least one instructor plus two interns working with the students at all times, giving the students a focused, well-supervised, creative learning experience.

There are 6 openings available. At the end of the two weeks, the production team will have completed a 5-10 minute video that will be entered into the 2009 Kids Summer Video Contest hosted by Plymouth Rock Studios. The contest awards ceremony will be held at the end of August. Details of the contest and awards festival will be announced in May 2009. On the final day of class (August 14th), there will be a movie premiere and pizza party, which parents will be invited to attend.

Parents may register their student by phone beginning at 10AM on May 1st. Parents who register their child have until June 30th to fill in the paperwork and pay the full tuition fee for the course. We suggest that parents bring their paperwork to the Cape Cod Community Media Center rather than mailing it to be sure it arrives on time. Payment may be made in cash, by check or money order, or by credit card.

Openings will be assigned by application, and there will be a limited waiting list. Openings will be offered to students on the waiting list if/when they become available.

Lunches are not provided. Students are expected to bring food and beverages with them. Parents will deliver and pick up their student to/from the instructors at the determined drop off/pick up site on location site days. All other days, students should be dropped off and picked up at the Cape Cod Community Media Center. Prompt drop off and pick up is expected. Parents who pick up their student late will be assessed a late pick up fee of \$25 per half hour.

To prevent sunburn, please provide your student with sunscreen and adequate clothing to cover up during the middle of the day (hats, long sleeved shirts, etc.) In case of bad weather, we will inform parents by 7AM on the day of the class by email if the drop off site will be changed. Please be sure to check your email in the morning before you drop your student off if there is any question about the weather.

Refund policy - if for some reason, your student cannot attend - a full tuition refund less \$30 processing fee before June 30th at 5PM. After June 30th at 5PM, tuition is non-refundable.
